



INTERNET AND SCHOOL NETWORK

Principles:

- Successful use of Gulf Islands Secondary School's on-line access to the Internet and the local network requires that users understand and respect that these are shared resources.
- Users are expected to conduct themselves in a legal, responsible, decent, ethical and polite manner while using the Internet or the school network.
- School computers are provided to assist students to complete school course work.
- All files on the school network are the property of the system owner, Gulf Islands Secondary School.

Process:

- Any students using computers outside of regular class time must have the specific permission of their classroom teacher.
- The system administrator reserves the right to access any files.
- The system administrator may remove the access of any user to the Internet and/or the local network for using the computers in an inappropriate manner.
- Any individual who becomes aware of improper use of the Internet or local network, or of any action that could compromise the school's computer system, is expected to report this information to school staff or the system administrator.
- Files are not normally kept from year to year. If special circumstances require files to be saved, students are expected to make the appropriate arrangements with their teachers.
- Students will be provided with access to the school's computer network after:
 - ß Completing basic usage classes
 - ß Signing a usage agreement
